

Full Text Journal Articles

You can click on "Full-Text Journals" on the library homepage and search the portal to determine if LMU-DCOM has full-text access to a journal.

When searching a database, if the article you want is not available in full-text, it may be available in another database or in the library's print collection. Library staff will scan articles from print journals and send them to you at your request.

To see if an article is available in full-text from within a database, click on the "Find It @Carnegie-Vincent Library" or "Reed Health Sciences Library" button.

Book Delivery

Health Sciences Library collections may be checked out and mailed to requestor. Print books are due at the end of the current semester. Other items, such as DVDs, may have shorter check out times.

Literature Search Requests



Literature searches may be requested by phone or email. Each request should ideally contain the following information:

- 1) Name
- 2) Institutional affiliation (LMU Branch)
- 3) Status (i.e. intern, 1st year resident, 2nd year resident, preceptor)
- 4) Contact information, including a follow-up number and email address in case a question or problem arises. Be sure to include the mailing address to which information should be sent.
- 5) Information requested (be specific, give alternate spellings, names, etc., if applicable)
- 6) Limiting features such as number of years to be searched, languages, human or non-human, age groups, type of article (i.e. review, research, clinical trials, etc.).

Catalog Search



The WorldCat Library Catalog allows users to search for print books, ebooks and journal articles all at once. It searches multiple databases simultaneously. Search by Author, Title, Keyword and other. Users can look for items available from LMU or in universities worldwide that can then be ordered through Inter-Library Loan.

Medical databases that are searched in the library catalog are:

- BioOne
- CINAHL
- Health Source: Consumer
- Health Source: Nursing/Academic
- Medline
- ProQuest Health and Medical Complete
- PsychINFO.

Interlibrary Loan

1. Find an item in the catalog or database.
2. Click on the green "Request Item" button.
3. Login to ILLIAD if you already have an account and skip to 7, OR
4. Click on "First Time Users"
5. Click on "First Time Users Click Here"
6. Fill out form and Submit
7. Request form should have information filled in the blanks. Confirm it is correct and click on "Submit Request" at bottom of page.
